 2. **Evaluation & Review** – The committee reviews submissions based on technical accuracy, relevance, innovation, and speaker expertise.
 3. **Final Selection** – Talks are chosen to create a **balanced and engaging agenda**.
 4. **Speaker Notification & Preparation** – Selected speakers are contacted and supported in refining their presentations.
